You will have an opportunity to gain experience and knowledge from our Family and Youth Services Team around working with youth and families living in Supportive Housing, Community Building and program planning, and inter-agency collaboration.

Core responsibilities will include helping plan and execute activities related to the Summer Program, working directly with youth attending the program, collaborating with Community Builders and other Avalon staff/interns, and helping run the Summer Food program we offer through Food Gatherers.
